A HAUNTED HOUSE

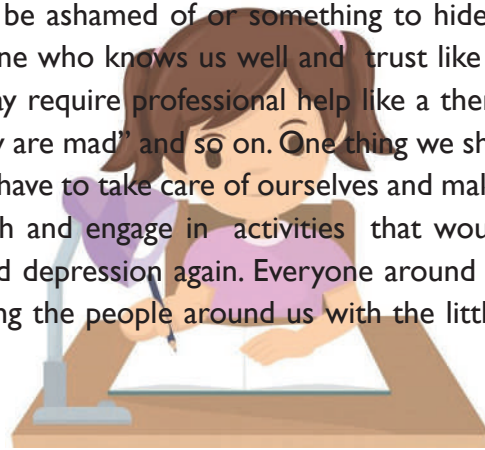

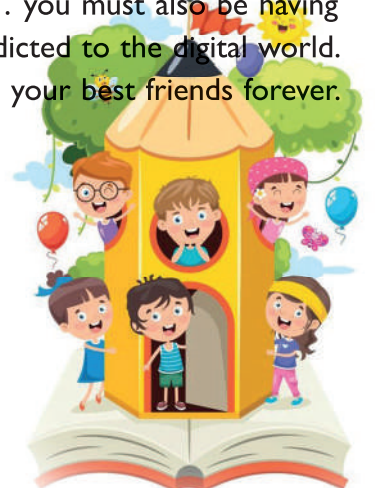


My Story
