Gearing Up for School: Equipped to Inspire, Prepared to Lead!

Teacher Orientation Programmes: Aligning Vision and Practice



The academic year had a fresh start with a staff meeting on 19th May, where our Headmistress, Ms. Bindu Thomas, welcomed the teachers and briefed them about the year's schedule, the tasks assigned to each teacher and the importance of team spirit and aligning with our institution's values and goals. On the same day a joint staff meeting was also conducted in the Main Auditorium. The schedule of the Teacher's Orientation Programme was handed over and planning for upcoming events was also discussed.



The teachers attended a Life Skills Session on 20th May, by Ms. Ajisha Sara Mohan, Assistant Professor at Sacred Heart College, Thevara, wherein the focus was on efficient decision-making, problem-solving and conflict resolution in students, as well as promoting values like respect, responsibility and compassion, fostering emotional intelligence and mental well-being.



On May 21st, we were blessed with a session with Rev. Fr. Benny Nalkara CMI, Provincial, Sacred Heart Province. Rev. Father enlightened the teachers about the CMI Vision and Mission and the approach every teacher must adopt to keep the CMI vision alive.

A New Chapter Begins: Initiation Day 2025



World Environment Day helped our little ones take their first step in becoming 'Earth's little Helpers', learning that even small acts of love and care can make our world a better and greener place.






Read, Imagine, Discover, One Day at a Time

Capacity Building Programme (CBP) on "Stress Management Techniques"







SACRED HEART DAY CELEBRATION JUNE 5: A DAY OF LOVE AND COMPASSION







LITTLE HEARTS, BIG LOVE-CELEBRATING GRANDPARENTS FROM THE HEART




